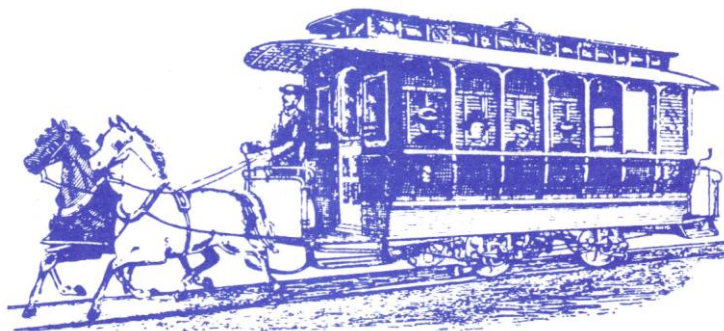

Discussion

The Zermatt Carousel is still at the Utah Adventure Resort in Midway Utah.

Saltair Park overlooking the Great Salt Lake was a popular amusement park for many years. The Salt Lake Garfield & Western Railroad provided electric interurban service between Salt Lake City and the park. The carousel figures were sold in the 1980s but the mechanism is now at the Carousel of Happiness in Nederland Colorado.

UA WA 800 B was previously listed. Please add the (logo) description to the obverse to distinguish it from newly listed UA WA 800 C.

Lake Lawn is a resort in Delavan WI. I have found no indication that a carousel is currently on the property.

The House on the Rocks is a very popular tourist attraction in Spring Green Wisconsin. It was built by Alex Jordan (1914-1989) in a very unusual architectural style and contains oddball artifacts that Jordan accumulated over his lifetime including a carousel. Guests are not permitted to ride the carousel.

TR NY 200 J is the 5th wooden nickel that we have listed from Village Taxi.

TR OH 200 B and C were issued by the same cab company that issued OH 230 X.

Although the maximum group number is 35, the group count for Manufacturer Samples is now 34 since group 26 (Vogelsong P.A.Y.E.) was removed in A-C 6E.
