



The Arkansas Power and Light Company (AP&L) was the primary electrical utility company for much of Arkansas from 1913 to 1989. The company was founded by Harvey Couch Sr. in 1914. As with many other electric utilities of the day it had many other business interests in addition to generating electricity. In 1933 AP&L owned forty-three miles of electric street trolley lines and 70 trolleys in central Arkansas. The line carried a total of 10.5 million passengers on a yearly basis. In 1935, in compliance with new laws separating traction lines from utility companies, AP&L's streetcar operations were transferred to the new Capital City Transportation Company.

AP&L issued two tokens during its operations, a school fare token in 1927 and a 1/2 fare child's token in 1928 which is shown below. The 23mm white metal token is listed in the Atwood-Coffee transit catalog as Arkansas – Little Rock 480-E. 10K examples were minted in two separate orders. Catalog valuation is given as \$4.50. In an August 2025 eBay auction this example sold for \$9.00 receiving 5 total bids.

Russian River Ferry – Cooper Landing Alaska #190-C

The world famous Russian River Ferry is located at the confluence of the Russian and Kenai Rivers on Alaska's beautiful Kenai Peninsula. The ferry services one of the most productive salmon sport fishing areas in all of North America. The ferry is a flat bottomed boat carrying 18 passengers from the federal boat landing to the prime fishing area across the river. It uses the rivers current only – no motor - and follows a cable. The ferry runs from 6AM to 11PM daily during fishing season – May to August – and charges \$12.00 per trip. The original ferry was a wooden boat started in the 1930's and the operation concession has been sold several times.

The ferry company has issued four different fare tokens during its operations. The example shown below is listed in the Atwood-Coffee transit catalog as Alaska #190-C. The 32mm brass tokens were minted in 1977 in a quantity of 3000 pieces each being consecutively numbered. The tokens have coin style reeding on the edges. Catalog valuation is \$8.50 with examples being readily available. There have been several recent (2024) sales on eBay with sale results from \$6.95 to \$14.33 with all receiving multiple bids.

Discussion

The Freeport IL carousel tokens are the 6th and 7th in the series.

Curtis Judge discovered an additional J.A.R. Bridge token which a bridge image on the obverse. The 7 varieties currently listed do not contain a bridge. Since the token appears to be rather worn, I will assume that it was really used.

The 2025 Missoula MT carousel token is the 71st issued by the carousel.

The Mansfield OH carousel has issued new tokens every year from 1991 to 2025.

Curtis Judge sent documentation for the Oklahoma City Silver Top Cab token. A newspaper article appeared in the Oklahoma City Advertiser dated March 25, 1932. A new taxi service Silver Top Cab was started in Oklahoma City. The company offered three fixed prices 15c, 25c or 35c depending on distance. The company intended to operate as many as 50 cabs and would employ 100 men. It is possible that 15¢ and 35¢ tokens also existed. How long this company remained in existence and whatever success it might have had are not known. A recent example sold on eBay for \$50 with just one bidder.

The AVA is continuing to sponsor Mitchell Palace Transit tokens. The 2025 editions are the 5th and 6th in the series.

El Mercado Square in San Antonio is the largest Mexican themed market in the United States. It is unknown what company operated the trolley ride.

City Of Vallejo Bus Lines – Submarine Pictorial Token –

California 945-L By: Curtis Judge

Vallejo is a city located in north central California near the San Francisco Bay. It was home to Mare Island Naval Shipyard a critical submarine facility during WW II, both for constructing and overhauling vessels. During WWII the city grew as did its private bus line which expanded to 11 routes which were operating 24 hours a day. After the war ended, population in Vallejo and ridership dropped drastically. The financially distressed company was sold to the city being renamed The City Of Vallejo Bus Lines. After the sale only six of the original eleven routes were still in operation and the company continued to struggle financially. In 1956 the city council sold the system to a private group of investors who formed Vallejo Citizens Transit.


City of Vallejo Bus Lines produced nine different tokens during its operations. The final token minted in 1952 is the most interesting incorporating a pictorial of a submarine, paying homage to the naval base. The 16mm white metal bar design token had a mintage of 20K pieces and is listed in the Atwood-Coffee transit catalog as California, Vallejo 945-L. Catalog valuation is given at \$3.00. Currently, Oct. 2025, there are three listing on eBay with “Buy It Now” prices ranging from \$12.99 to \$16.99. Apparently, the submarine pictorial commands a large premium over catalog value.



The following 1950 photo shows Bus #39 one of the REO coaches used by the City Of Vallejo Bus lines. Color photos show that the livery was a yellow roof over a brown base.



The company issued transfers for riders wishing to switch routes without having to pay an additional fare. The date and time were punched into the transfer by the driver.
