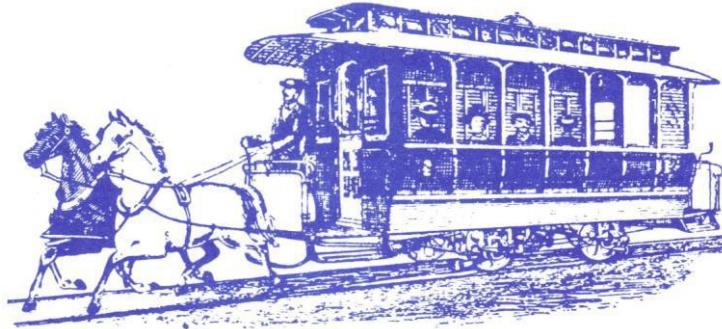

## Discussion

PORTLAND OR 700 AB has the same obverse as OR 700 K but the same reverse as OR 700 J. Alpenrose Dairy in Portland (actually in unincorporated Clackamas south of Portland) was founded in 1891. It had 52 acres of grounds which included Dairyville which was a replica of a western frontier town. Dairyville was typically open in the summer and on holidays.

In 2020, Dairyville's assets were auctioned off and the property was permanently closed. In 2022, Alpenrose Dairy was sold to Smith Brothers Farms. Some Alpenrose products are still sold by Smith Brothers. There is a proposal currently to build a subdivision on the former Alpenrose property.

Steve Sutherland reported yet another variety of the Ludlow House token from Monroe WI. This one is similar to WI 530 D except that it has no dot after LINE. Like C and D, the beaded edge is on the reverse only.

The Ludlow House was named by its founder Arabut Ludlow (1818-1896). Ludlow started as a fur trader plying a route from Green Bay to Chicago. Monroe was a stopping point on his journeys. Ludlow fell in love with the area and decided to settle there. He became a major land owner in the area and founded the First National Bank of Monroe. He later built the Ludlow Hotel, the most prominent hotel in Monroe. Although the hotel is long gone, Ludlow's 17 room mansion still stands and is utilized for various events.

# Tyneside Tramways & Tramroads Co 1D Fare Token – England 812AB

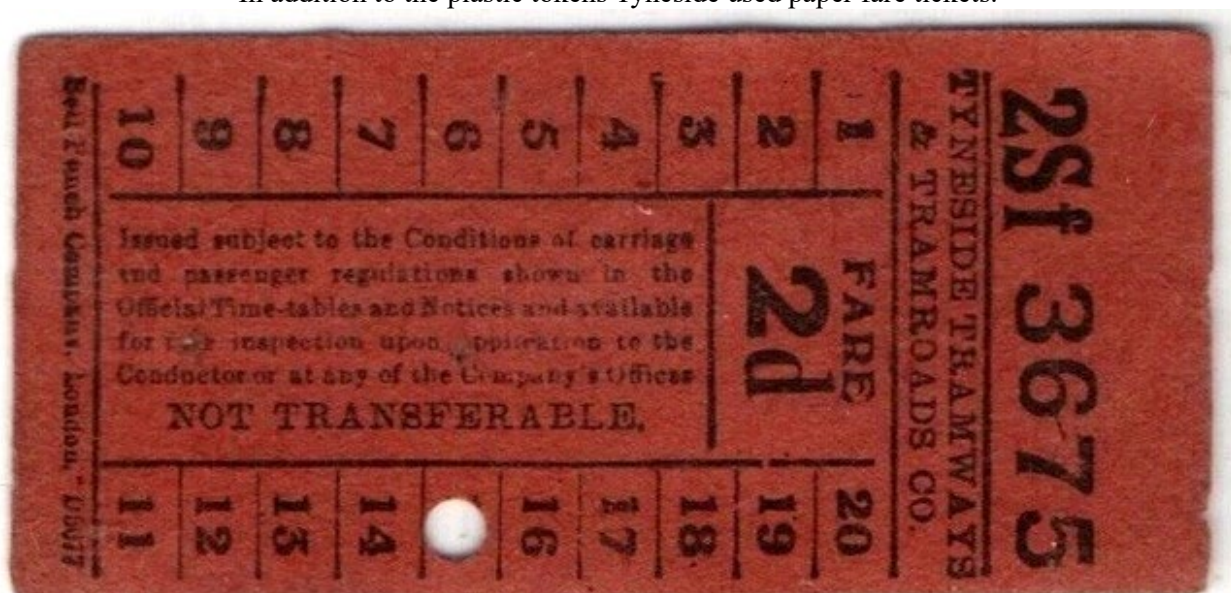

Tyneside Tramways and Tramroads Company built an electric tramway as was authorized by the Tyneside Tramways and Tramroad Act Of 1901. At the western end, it connected with Newcastle Corporation Tramways. At the eastern end, it connected with the Tynemouth & District Electric Traction Co. Service started on 4 September 1902. The chairman of the company was John Theodore Metz. British Electric Traction took controlling interest in the Tyneside Tramways and Tramroads Company in 1913. In 1920, the company applied for an act of Parliament, enabling them to run omnibus services. The tramway service closed on 6 April 1930 after which the company ran a motor bus service until 1975 as the Tyneside Omnibus Company.

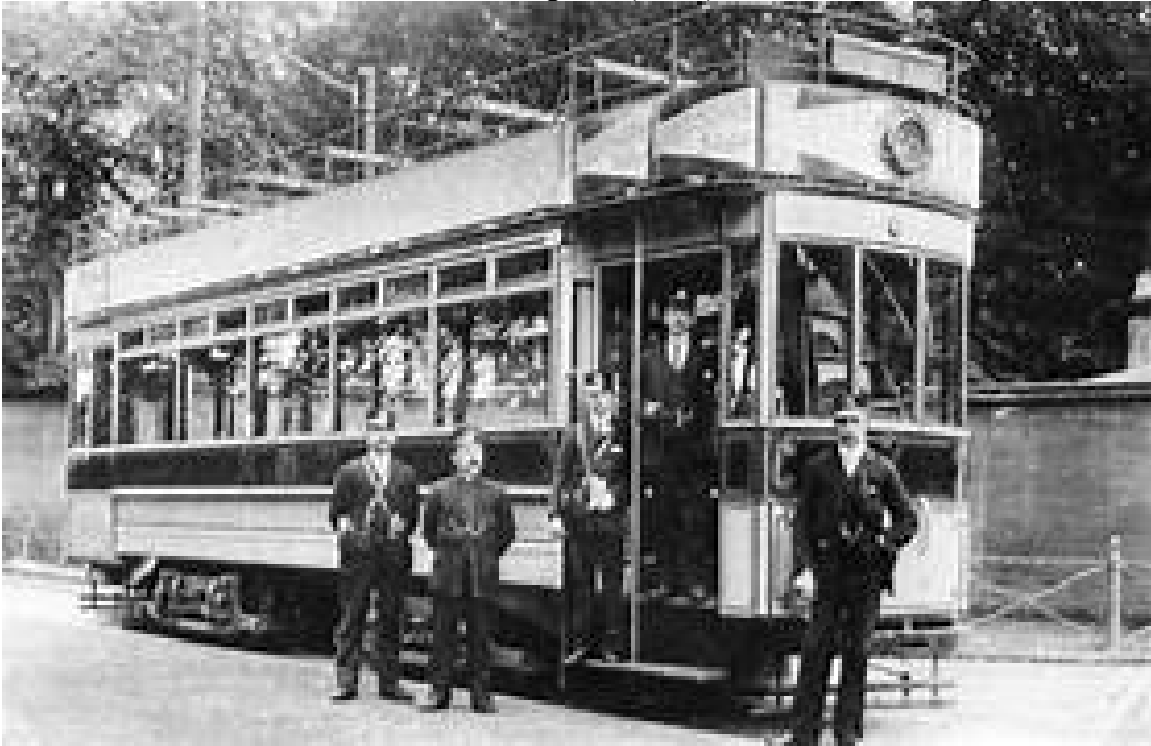
Tyneside issued two fare tokens during its operations. The 23mm white plastic example shown below is listed in Smith's 1990 international catalog as England, Walsend # 812-AB. Travel fare was 1D. A green ½ D token was also issued cataloged as 812-AA. The obverse features a TT&TTC lettered monogram and the company name. Smiths catalog valuation was \$1.00, current 2026 auction sales range from \$1.50-3.00.



In addition to the plastic tokens Tyneside used paper fare tickets.



This photo shows one of the early electric trams used by Tyneside.  
The trams were double deck, enclosed on the lower for weather protection.  
The trams carried a three man crew – one engineer (driver) and two fare collecting conductors.



After 1920 the company instituted omnibus service that lasted until 1975.  
This photo shows one of the later double deck bus varieties used by Tyneside.

## Hot Springs AR 435 16mm Tokens Ken Smith

Hot Springs Street Railroad was a horsecar line, and operated from about 1889 until 1893. It was taken over by Hot Springs Street Railway in 1893. Hot Springs Street Railway operated from 1893 to July 1, 1966, when it's lines were sold to Spa Transit, Inc. Streetcars were abandoned here on October 15, 1938.

Four 16mm tokens were used throughout the time that the line was in operation.

AR 435 J had 3 different orders which were:

AR 435 J- a struck in WM in the 1920,s had a Wide H and was used for STREETCAR and had a square dot.

AR 435 J- b struck in WM in 1942 had a Narrow H and was used for Bus and had a round dot.

AR 435 J- c struck in WM in 1950 had a curved H and was use for Bus and had a round dot.

AR 435 K struck in Zinc in 1943 had a Narrow H and used for Bus.

AR 435 L struck in WM in 1966-1967 had the H removed by the company.

AR 435 M struck in Zinc in 1966-1967 had the H removed by the company.

## Money Meters Providence, R.I. Manufacturers Sample Token # 17-C by C.Judge

The Money Meters Company of Providence, R. I. operated in the 1920-30's. It supplied several different product lines to the public transportation companies including tokens, change making devices and fare counting devices. Money Meters produced 5 different advertising tokens which were salesman's samples representing the company's capabilities using various metals, sizes, shapes, wording and cutout designs. The white metal 23mm token shown below is one of their issues listed in the Atwood-Coffee Transit catalog as Manufacturers Sample Group 17-C. Catalog valuation is given as \$3.00. These tokens are not common and usually sell for multiples of catalog value.



In addition to tokens the company produced change makers that were supported on the conductors belt with tubes for penny, nickel, dime and quarters that were dispensed by moving the lever on the front. Also made were coin / token counters that were held in hand with the middle finger in the ring and the index finger pressing on the pad to move the token through the device adding it to the count. These devices can auction for \$30.00 into the hundreds of dollars depending on condition and operational status.
