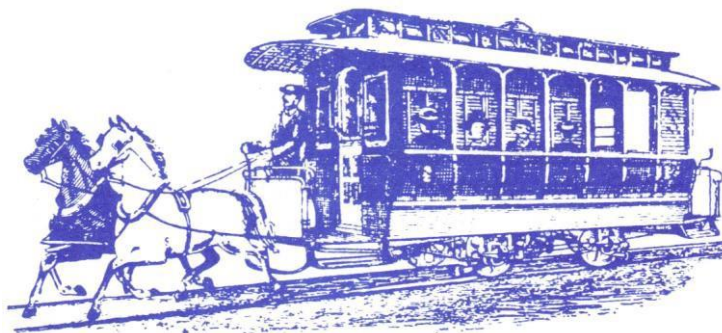

Get Ready to Bid – AVA Auction Preview!

This issue of The Fare Box features the upcoming AVA Auction, which will be held live at the AVA Convention in Washington, PA at 9:00 AM on Saturday, August 22. This auction is packed with a wide selection of quality transportation tokens, along with many other desirable items you won't want to miss.

Here's the key to winning:

Transportation tokens in AVA auctions open at their Atwood-Coffee catalog value—and history shows that early bids at catalog value often win. If you want a strong chance at securing tokens at catalog price, don't wait. Be the first to place your bid, because in the event of a tie, the earliest bid takes it.

Whether you plan to attend the Convention or not, you can (and should!) bid in advance. Many successful bidders lock in their wins before the auction even begins.

You'll also find some damaged tokens offered below catalog value. These are priced accordingly and often represent rare opportunities—sometimes the only affordable way to add certain tokens to your collection.

In addition to tokens, the auction includes a variety of other items, all starting at very reasonable opening bids. Minimum bids are clearly listed, so once again, early bidding gives you the advantage. We will do our best to include photos of all non-transportation items in this issue and the next.

Don't sit this one out—get your bids in early and give yourself the edge!

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Kansas City-Western Railway – One City Fare Token

Kansas # 550-Aa By: Curtis Judge

Kansas City – Western Railway was chartered in 1901, raised capital and started operations shortly thereafter. The 26 mile electric trolley system ran interurban service between Kansas City and Leavenworth also providing city route service in Leavenworth. Another company held the city franchise in Kansas City. The line was succeeded by the Kansas City, Leavenworth & Western Railway on June 3, 1920 after bankruptcy was declared and the company was placed in receivership.

The company issued a single 21mm white metal token good for a Leavenworth city fare in 1915. There are two known varieties one with a period after CO and one without the period. The die work is consimilar with both sides using the same design. The with period example shown below is listed in the Atwood-Coffee transit catalog as Kansas, Leavenworth #550-Aa. Both tokens have a 2mm center hole and have a catalog valuation of \$35.00. Recent auction results could not be located.

What is a Parking Token? A Parking Token is a token used to park a vehicle. The city and state where it is or was used to do that is known and will be used when the token is placed in a catalog. In addition, there are Catalog Categories that are tokens involved with parking activities but are not used to facilitate the actual parking activity. There is a pull down in TC.COM that is labeled "ADDITIONAL INFO" that provides an introduction to Parking Tokens. After logging in, a collector can get the definitions of the various parking groups.

Collector "Silverbullet" found an "ALLRIGHT PARKING" token posted as being PTUN 3164 in the unknown Catalog group. Digging a little deeper we found PTUN 3001 and PTUN 3166 also being "ALLRIGHT PARKING" tokens. He also found their company's Corporate Office was in Memphis, Tennessee. While these tokens did not have a customer's name on them, they could be part of stock tokens the company had. The three tokens are coming out of PTUN and going into PTMS. Thank you "Silverbullet"

Perey Turnstile Fare Token / Green Bus Lines **Queens, New York # 631-H** By: Curtis Judge

Green Bus Lines, was a private bus company in New York City. It operated local service in Queens and express service to Manhattan until January 9, 2006, when the city-operated MTA Bus Company took over its routes. Green Bus Lines routes primarily operated in the Jamaica, Ozone Park, Howard Beach, South Jamaica, and the Rockaways areas of Queens, along with service to the passenger and cargo areas of JFK International Airport. At the time of its closure, Green Lines operated more local and limited bus routes than any other private company in the city.

The 24mm brass Perey Turnstile token shown below was used by Green Bus Lines on a single route from 1941 to 1950. 1000 pieces were struck in 1941. The token is listed in the Atwood Coffee transit catalog as New York, Queens # 631 H and given a \$5.00 catalog valuation. This example was listed for sale in a March, 2026 eBay auction and sold for the "Buy It Now" price of \$6.99. The tokens are not common and usually sell for multiples of catalog valuation.

Perey Turnstile Company is a manufacturer of fare collection, security access and people control devices often used in subways, sports stadiums, government facilities and other venues. The company is still operating and based in Connecticut. The connection between Green and Perey could not exactly be determined. Other transit companies have in the past received a discount on token purchases if advertising could be placed on their tokens. One green Line access point was probably controlled by a Perey Turnstile product and these tokens purchased from Perey for speed and convenience of acquisition.

The left hand photo shows one of the low security three arm access control devices that were in common usage in subways. Coins or tokens were inserted in a slot on the top allowing the arm to rotate for access by a single person. For more secure or problem locations where people jumped over the three arm designs, rotating cage configuration turnstiles were also offered. These designs have been replaced with phone or farecard access configurations.
